The National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy was held 13–15 May 2008.

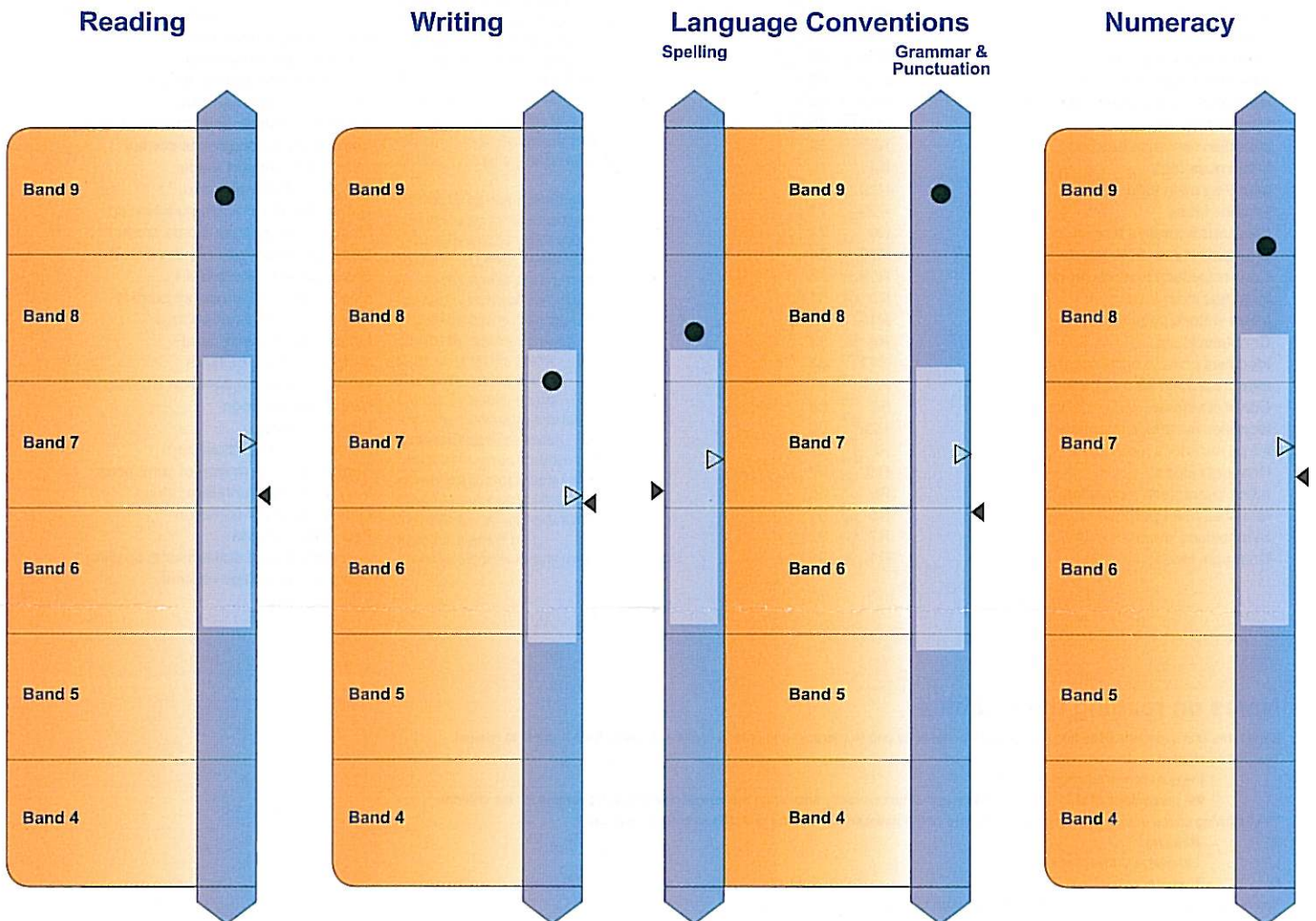
This Additional Student Report 2008 is provided by the NSW Department of Education and Training for students in NSW public schools.
